#### WHAT THEY MAKE

Matta<sup>™</sup> manufactures safety surfacing products containing a high proportion of recycled truck tyre rubber. Their recycled products are made from up to 95% recycled materials which include end-of-life tyres but also road cones, deflated pool toys and gumboots.

Top layer made from PVC

Shock pad made from recycled materials including tyres.



The founder of Matta<sup>™</sup>, Murray Scott, saw an opportunity to divert waste from landfill and pioneered a whole new manufacturing process and generation of safety surfacing products.

They've turned more than 60 million kg of waste plastic and rubber otherwise destined for landfill into highly durable and safe surfacing products.

- Recycling waste materials to create new products minimises the use of virgin materials in production and supports a circular economy.
